Lincoln Park Solar Co-op Information Session

Homeowners in the Lincoln Park neighborhood have formed a solar co-op. Co-op members will use their group buying power to get a discounted price for solar panels. If you've ever wanted to go solar and live in the Lincoln Park neighborhood, now is your chance. There is an information session on Wednesday, June 15, 6:30 p.m., at SE Neighborhood Library, 403 Seventh St. SE

Based on the same principle as buying in bulk, co-op members purchase solar systems together to save money and share knowledge. The group uses a competitive bidding process to select a single company that will install systems on all of the participating homes. Each participant signs his or her own contract with the installer, but everyone gets the bulk discount. By going solar as a group, participants can save up to 20% off the cost of a solar system. You'll also have the support of the group instead of navigating an often-complicated process alone. DC SUN and Community Power Network are supporting the group effort. 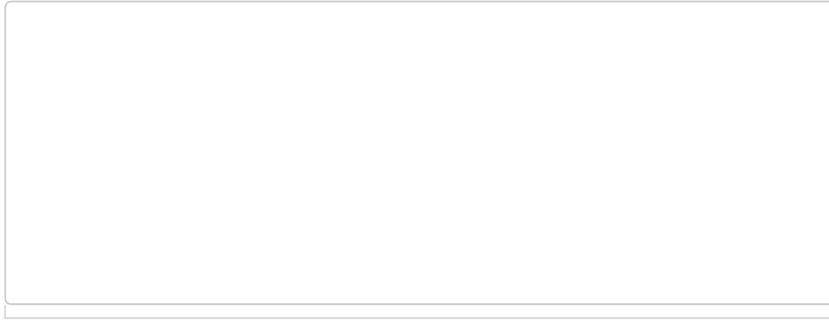
