



Florida Municipal Utility Bills Compared to Investor-Owned Utility Bills

In Florida, average residential municipal electric utility (muni) bills are lower than average residential electric investor-owned utility (IOU) bills. For 2021 and 2022, the overall totals for IOUs and munis were calculated based on the overall residential revenue and customer

number for each type of utility¹. In 2021 residential municipal utility bills were on average \$12 lower, and, in 2022, \$12.50 lower than IOU residential bills. In 2023, only monthly data is available through November for the IOUs and one muni: JEA². For 2023, IOU bills average from \$173 to \$195 with JEA bills \$35+ less per month at only \$138.
